



CityLink Tulla Widening

Change of access from Lennon Street Flemington Road interchange

The Flemington Road interchange is being upgraded to improve the safety and operation of this extremely busy and complex intersection.

In order to create a safer intersection, access from Lennon Street to Boundary Road will be permanently removed in late February. Currently, to access Boundary Road from Lennon Street, drivers veer across three lanes of traffic exiting the freeway in an uncontrolled environment, which is dangerous and blocks traffic flow on the Flemington Road exit ramp during peak hours, holding up drivers.

What changes are being made?

From late February, drivers will no longer be able to access Boundary Road from Lennon Street via the freeway exit ramp. Once this change has taken place, drivers will be able to access Boundary Road from Lennon Street using three alternate routes, outlined over the page.

The new traffic conditions will improve safety at this intersection, with drivers no longer crossing traffic on the Flemington Road exit ramp. This arrangement will accommodate the new lanes on the Flemington Road exit ramp, with traffic turning from Lennon Street only able to access Flemington Road inbound lanes.

We are currently working with the community to look at a range of options to find a longer term solution that works for residents and the community.

Current unsafe traffic movements through the intersection:



Alternate routes - Lennon Street to Boundary Road

It will no longer be possible to travel directly across the Flemington Road freeway exit ramp from Lennon Street to Boundary Road.



Option 1 via Erskine Street and Melrose Street

- Turn left onto Flemington Road
- Turn right onto Abbotsford Street
- Turn right onto Erskine Street
- Turn right onto Melrose Drive
- Turn left onto Sutton Street
- Turn left onto **Boundary Road**

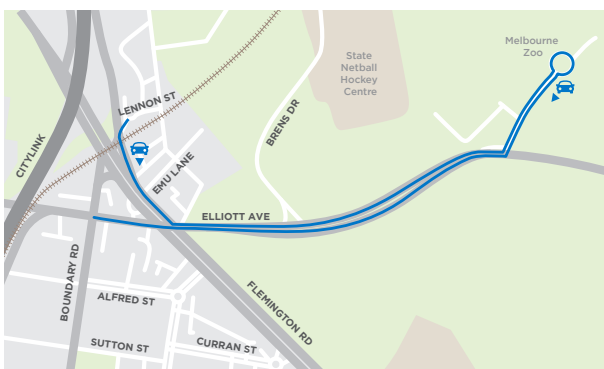
Approximate distance: 2km



Option 2 via Erskine Street and Flemington Road

- Turn left onto Flemington Road
- Turn right onto Abbotsford Street
- Turn right onto Erskine Street
- Turn right onto Dryburgh Street
- Turn left onto Flemington Road
- Turn left onto Racecourse Road
- Turn left onto **Boundary Road**

Approximate distance: 1.8km



Option 3 via Elliott Avenue

- Turn left onto Flemington Road
- Turn left onto Elliott Avenue (eastbound)
- Turn back at Melbourne Zoo onto Elliott Avenue (westbound)
- Turn left onto **Boundary Road**

Approximate distance: 3km

Flemington Road interchange is a complex, crowded intersection. As part of upgrades to improve safety and traffic flow, Lennon Street access will soon change to limit dangerous and uncontrolled vehicle movements.
